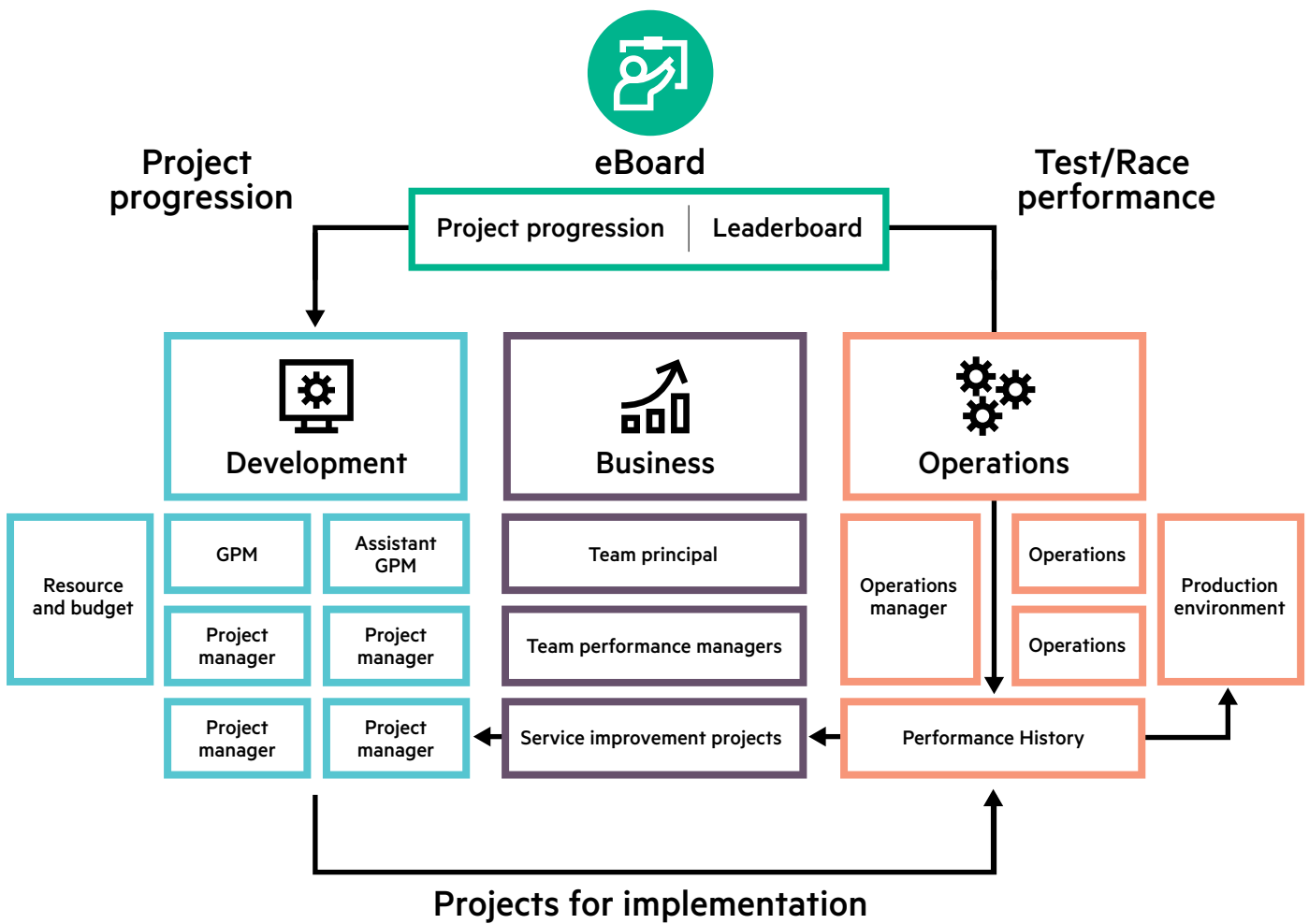


Figure 1. Race-to-Results PM Simulation design
