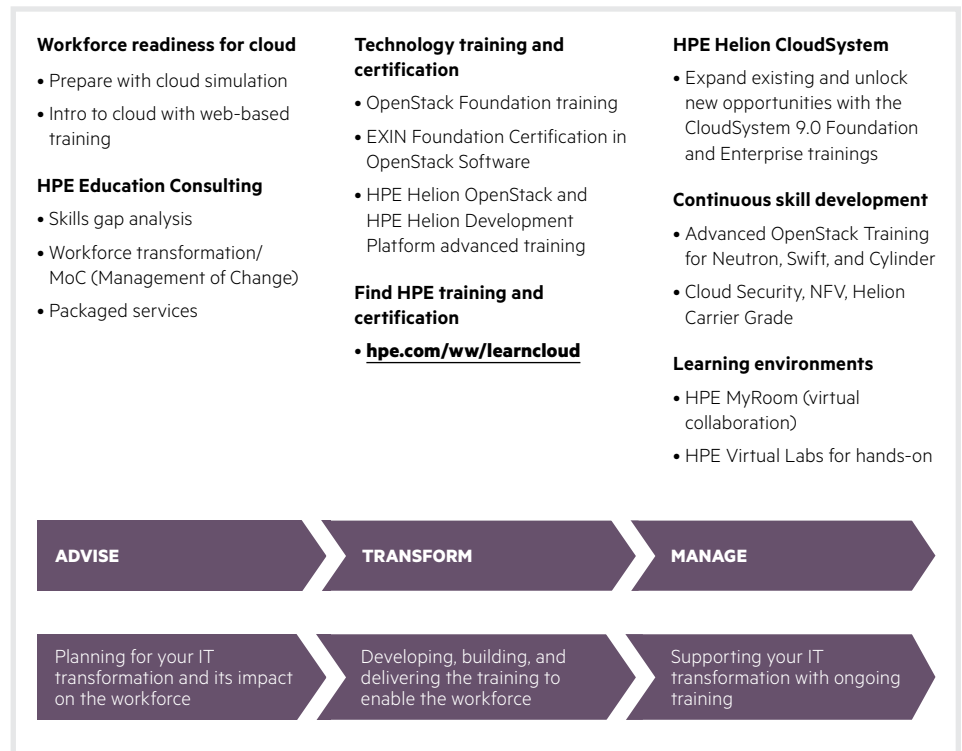


Figure 1. Enable workforce for your cloud journey and HPE Helion

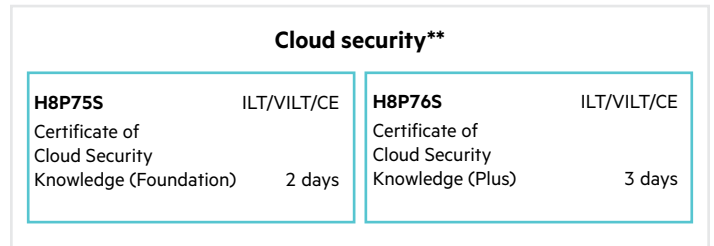
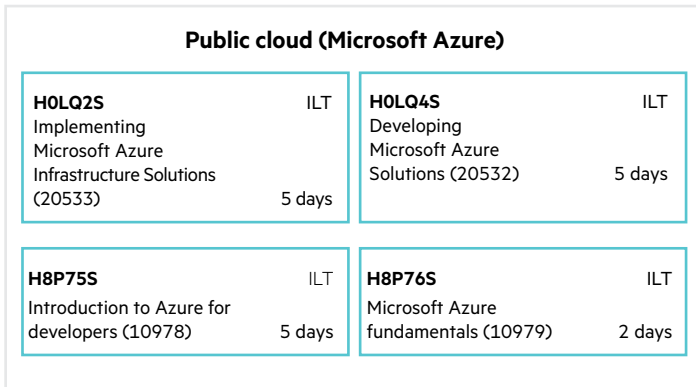
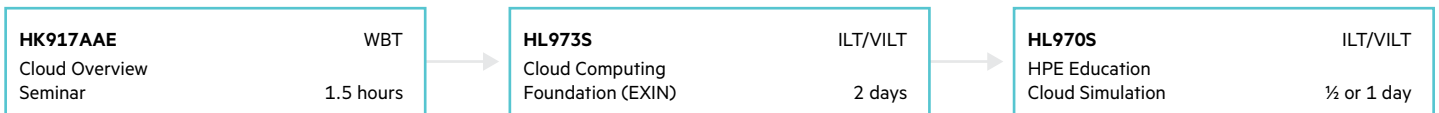

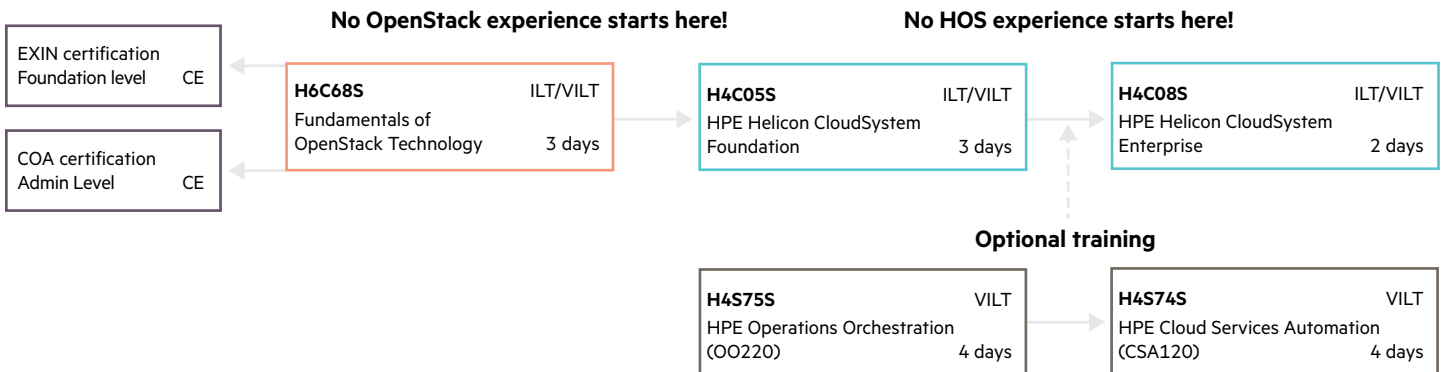


Figure 3. HPE Helion CloudSystem Curriculum

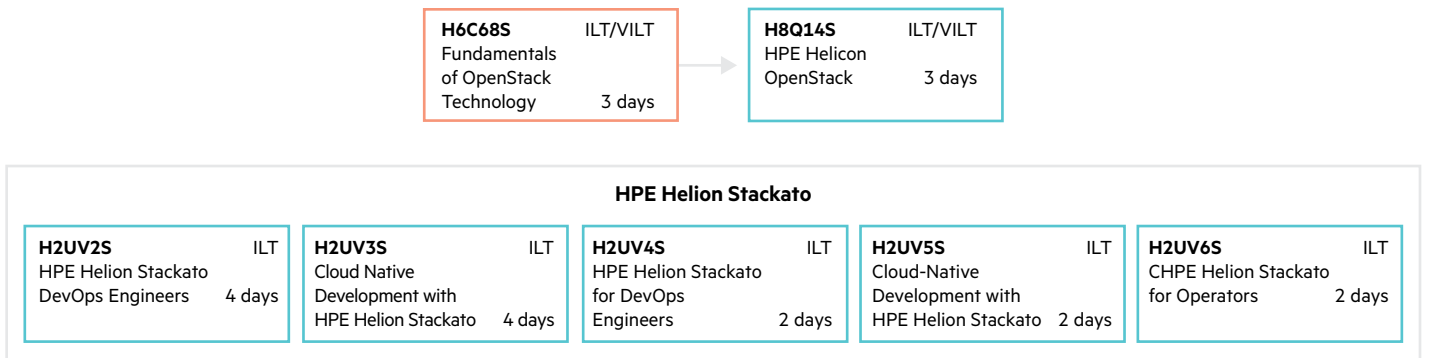


Figure 4. HPE Helion OpenStack Curriculum

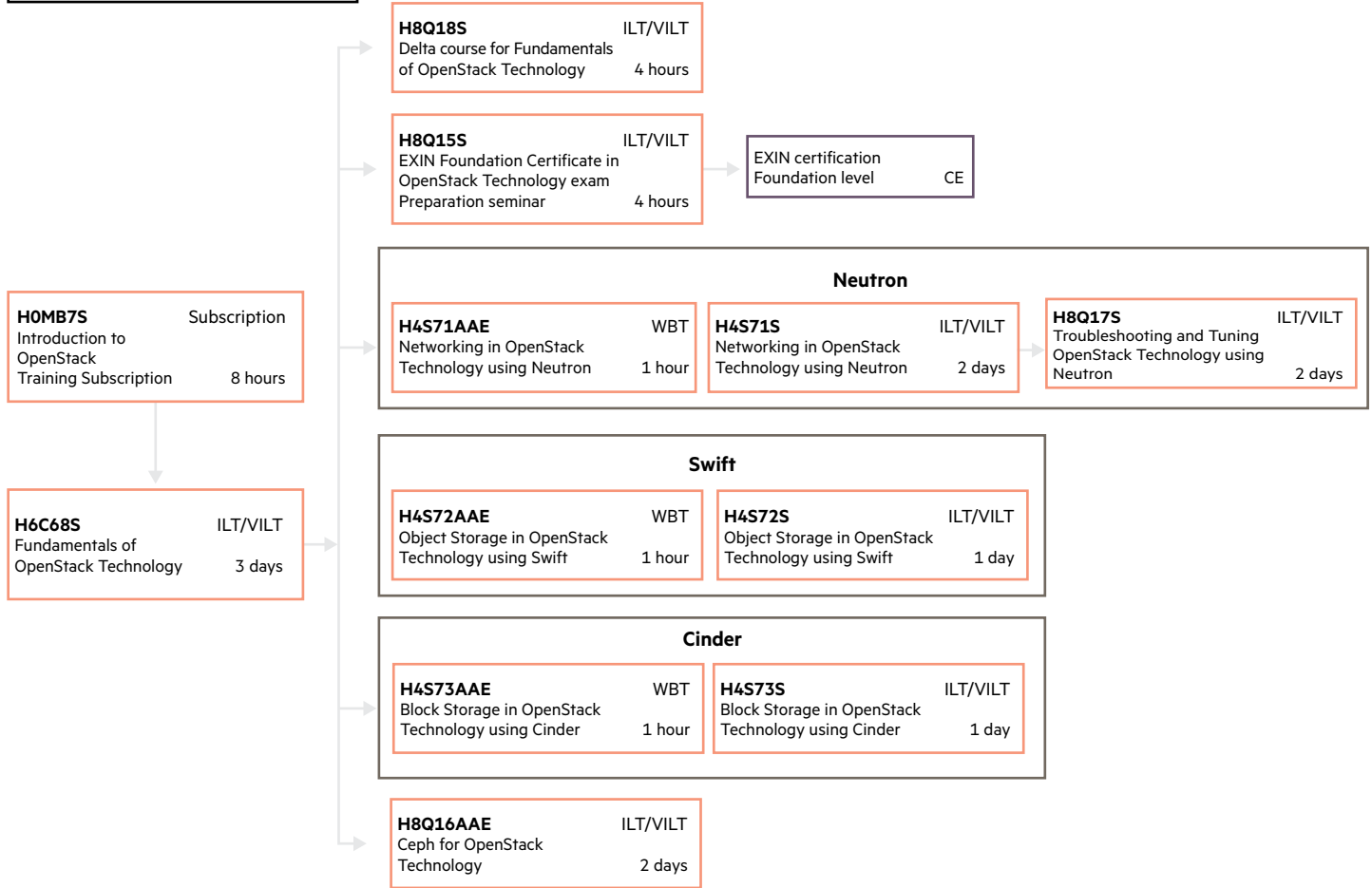


Figure 5. OpenStack Technology Curriculum
