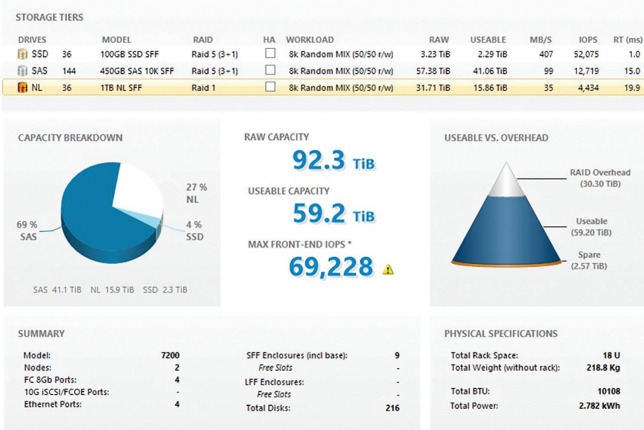


Figure 1: System configuration and capacity details

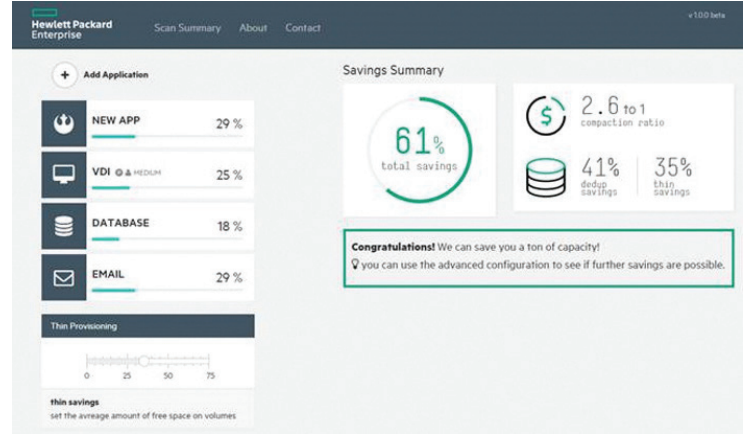


Figure 2: HPE Storage Assessment Foundry Get Thinner Tool

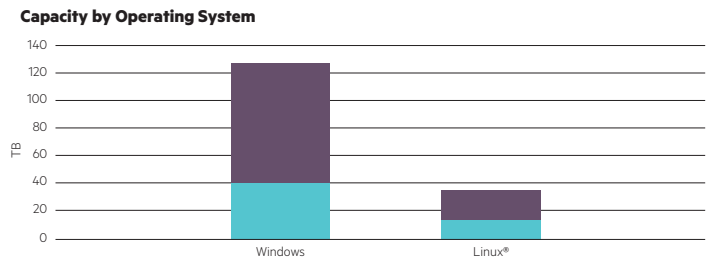
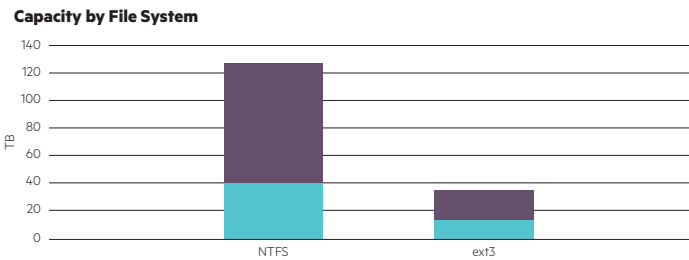


Figure 3: View capacity usage by operating and file systems
